- What we've learned so far (climate findings, findings from listening sessions and student engagement)
- Get input from participants on what their vision is for the future, building from local priorities and the future climate impacts

#### 4. Public meeting #2 (In person)

### • Agenda:

- Share about the chapter topics and adaptation
- Use breakouts to get input from the public on specific parts of the planning work they're interested in
- Share link to town-wide survey

#### 5. Town-wide online survey

- To hear from the public:
  - What matters to you? What future do you want?
  - What input do you have on the chapter topics?
- Open to the entire community for ~3 weeks
- Project team will compile findings report that is available to the public
